Regarding: Changes effective Monday, January 12, 2015 at the Medina County Solid Waste District Facility

As you all may be aware, the District has reduced tipping fees for rubbish delivered to the Medina County Solid Waste District Facility located at 8700 Lake Road, Seville. Effective January 12, 2015, the tip fee is \$57.00/ton flat rate, with no fuel surcharges for the first quarter of 2015. Fuel surcharges will be calculated per contract with the County's contracted hauler for transfer, transport and disposal of waste delivered to the Solid Waste Facility, Kimble Company, with notifications made to you of any adjustments through District invoicing for the second, third and fourth quarters of the year.

Hours of operation and scale house services remain unchanged. Haulers to the facility are expected to haul to their current schedules and deliver at their standard times. Residents will still be on site disposing of bagged waste, bulk rubbish and yard waste, and dropping recyclable materials into bins. We will all continue to share space and ask that you continue to be respectful to others and their traffic patterns.

The District is operated under flow control rules, which as a reminder, requires that all rubbish generated within the District must be delivered to the County's Solid Waste Facility. Violators to this policy will be subject to further administrative action.

During this transitional period from the single-contract oversight of all facility operations by Envision Waste Services to several smaller singular contracts, the first of which was awarded to Kimble Company, you will be directed by District personnel on-site in the scale house, and in the yard, to make the transition as seamless as possible. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we complete the transition.

If your drivers report any delays or problems during this transitional time frame, we encourage you to immediately phone District personnel for assistance. The District was unsuccessful in converting the existing phone number (330) 769-1273 from the current contractor into the County's name. Regrettably, that phone number is no longer in service to contact County personnel at the County's Solid Waste Facility. New contact numbers/names are as follows:

To advise on a few housekeeping items, any prior practice of "waste exchange" by haulers for out-of-county to in-county waste for mixed loads collected across District boundaries shall be discontinued effective immediately. Waste delivered to the Solid Waste Facility shall be generated and collected within the Medina County Solid Waste District.

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Also, please be advised that haulers with frozen loads, including roll-off containers, that will require the assistance of Kimble Company's personnel/equipment to scrape and release the frozen load, may be directed to a secondary waiting area and experience longer wait times. If you expect that your load is frozen, please contact the scale house operator at the number listed above so that they may give advance notice of your arrival to the Solid Waste Facility. It is our goal to move you through the Facility as expeditiously as possible.

Thank you for your continued cooperation and support of the District's solid waste management activities.
