Medina County Solid Waste District and Rumpke Team to Bring Single-Stream Recycling Program

MEDINA COUNTY, OH – July 15, 2020 – Medina County will begin a new single-stream recycling drop-box program with Rumpke Waste & Recycling in August.

The program will begin the week of August 15, 2020. Nearly 170 single stream recycling drop-off containers will be distributed at 63 recycling locations throughout the county.

“Bringing single-stream recycling to Medina County is a great opportunity to increase recycling” said Beth Biggins-Ramer, Medina County Solid Waste District Coordinator. “With the new program, residents can combine all accepted recyclables in the Rumpke single stream recycling drop-off containers without sorting them by type. It makes it easy and convenient.”

Accepted recyclables are identified by picture on the front of each single stream recycling drop-off container. Recyclables are limited to the following, which should be placed *un-bagged* into Rumpke single stream recycling drop-off containers:

- Plastic bottles and jugs (please empty, flatten and reattach the lid)
- Beverage cartons
- Glass bottles and jars (any color)
- Aluminum and steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans (with lids and tips removed)
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, 12-pack containers, etc.)
- Cardboard (please flatten)
- Paper products, including newspaper, magazines, office paper, junk mail and envelopes.

The following items should never be placed in the Rumpke single stream recycling drop-off containers: trash, plastic bags, clothing, batteries, scrap metal, toys, furniture or hazardous materials.

Recycling sites include:

- Buehler’s Fresh Food Grocery Stores in Medina, Montville and Wadsworth
- Habitat for Humanity Restore, 233 Lafayette Road
- Smith Bros., Inc., 3087 Marks Road and 7170 Wooster Pike Road
